

# Basic website setup

## Registrar

The company that you register your domain with eg mywebsitename.com.au

## Delegation

Your *host* will supply you with “*Delegation codes*” that allows you to point your domain to your *host*. When you login to your *registrars* website, there will be somewhere to add your “*delegation codes*”. The codes will typically look like this:

ns1.myhostcompany.com.au  
ns2.myhostcompany.com.au  
ns3.myhostcompany.com.au  
ns4.myhostcompany.com.au

After 1-48 hours of adding these codes, your *domain* will now point to your *host*.

Most companies are both *Registrars* and *Hosts*. We recommend keeping these separate. If you hosting sucks, you can move hosts more easily if they are separate!
